Every summer, we have six weeks of creative and fun-filled classes scheduled for children of all ages. As a volunteer, you are essential to helping us make sure that these six weeks are as amazing as they can possibly be. Every day, you will help to assist our awesome art instructors in their classes as well as supervise the students during their outside time. We want to ensure your success by providing you with the following guidelines:

- 1. Our number one priority is safety. Attentively and consistently monitor students' behavior. Wherever the students are is where you need to be. Everyone should feel both physically and emotionally safe while at our facilities. Please alert staff whenever an incident occurs, even if it seems minor or insignificant.
 - a. Please keep your mobile devices on silent and put away, and please notify the teacher and step out of the classroom if you need to attend to an urgent call/text.
- 2. Motivate students to act kindly and considerately towards the instructors, staff, volunteers, and their fellow students. Children learn best through observation and mirroring, meaning, your own behavior is the best teacher.
- 3. Encourage the students to pay attention to and follow the teachers' and/or staffs' instructions and rules.
- 4. Keep students focused on their own work and not on distracting or disrupting other students work.
- 5. Engage in discussion with students about the work that they are doing in class as well as their own personal lives. Humans are social creatures! Everyone just wants to feel seen and heard and like they belong.
